

## 6 Night Delta, Moremi and Chobe Supreme

- **2 Nights Stanley's Camp**
- **2 Nights Chief's Camp**
- **2 Nights Chobe Chilwero**

### **Day 1 to Day 3:**

Upon your arrival into Maun Airport you will be met and welcomed by a representative from **The Booking Company**, who will welcome you and who will assist you with your connection onto light aircraft for your flight to Stanley's Camp, where you will stay for 2 nights.

Set in an amphitheatre of ebony and sausage trees on the southern tip of Chief's Island, **Stanley's Camp** borders the southern section of the Moremi Game Reserve. The floodwaters arrive around June, though there is often navigable water all year round due to the presence of the Boro River.

Stanley's Camp consists of 8 classic styled safari tents raised on wooden decking. The decks are complemented with hammocks and Morris chairs. Each unit offers en-suite facilities and a private balcony.

The main building is raised on decking and offers expansive views over the surrounding floodplains. The structure was built into the existing tree line, its main support being a large sausage tree.

The area is home to a wide variety of big game including elephant, buffalo, giraffe, hippo, lion, leopard, cheetah and wild dog. Game-drives are conducted in open 4 X 4 vehicles and are conducted early morning and late afternoon or as otherwise requested (subject to availability) and accompanied by professional guides. The unique and educational elephant interaction is also available. Mokoro excursions and game walks are also offered.

**Included:** Light aircraft flight from Maun to Stanley's Camp, 2 nights Stanley's Camp, accommodation, all meals, local brand beverages, laundry service, lodge included activities **PLUS** the elephant activity

**Excluded:** Premium brand beverages, elephant activity and curio purchases

### **Day 3 to Day 5:**

After an early morning activity and breakfast, if time permits; you will connect with light aircraft for your flight to Chief's Camp, where you will stay for 2 nights.

**Chief's Camp** is situated in the Mombo Concession of the Moremi Game Reserve, known as the "predator capital" of Africa and is considered to have the finest game viewing in southern Africa. The area is also home to the Big Five. It is situated on the northwestern tip of Chief's Island, in what is termed seasonal delta. Generally, the floodwaters infiltrate the area in June / July and remain for a period of 4 to 5 months.

Chief's Camp comprises 12 luxury tents (24 beds), which are secluded, permanent luxury bush pavilions. Each unit offers en-suite bathrooms and private game viewing decks.

The main lodge complex houses the dining area, bar, curio shop, library and reception area. This structure was built into the existing landscape, under a heavy canopy of mature Jackal berry, Sausage and Rain trees.

The main deck area is split-level and offers expansive views over the floodplain to the north. The lower level of the deck houses the swimming pool. A range of spa treatments is offered in a poolside treatment sala (peak season only).

This area is also renowned for its large concentrations of plains-game, elephant and buffalo and offers good sightings of the predators.

Professionally guided game-drives are conducted in open 4 X 4 vehicles in the early morning and late afternoon or as otherwise requested (subject to availability).

Mokoro excursions are offered in high season only, subject to water levels.

Your stay at Chief's Camp is inclusive of accommodation, all meals, all local brand drinks, scheduled safari activities, park entrance fees and laundry.

***Included:*** Light aircraft flight from Stanley's Camp to Chief's Camp, 2 nights Chief's Camp, accommodation, all meals, local brand beverages, laundry service, national park fees and activities

***Excluded:*** Premium brand beverages and curio purchases

#### **Day 5 to Day 7:**

After an early morning activity and breakfast, if time permits; you will connect with light aircraft to Kasane Airport, where you will be met and welcomed by a representative from Chobe Chilwero. You will transfer to the lodge, where you will stay for 2 nights.

***Chobe Chilwero*** borders the Chobe National Park, the second largest National Park in Botswana. Chilwero, means "place of high view" in the local language of Setswana. The lodge sits above the Chobe River and offers unparalleled panoramic views across the islands and flood plains as far as Namibia.

Chobe Chilwero has 15 stone & thatched bungalows, 6 double and 9 twins. Each cottage has its own en-suite bathroom with a large sunken bath, indoor and outdoor showers and private garden. The main public area includes a lounge and dining room, which are linked to outdoor viewing patios. The wine cellar is temperature controlled and houses a large variety of the finest South African and European wines. A range of spa treatments is offered at Chobe Chilwero. The lodge also boasts a split-level swimming pool, library, curio shop and an e-communications center, which offers telephone, fax and internet access.

Chobe National Park covers a diversity of landscapes ranging from riverine forests to floodplains and periodic marshlands. The area is home to the largest concentration of elephants in Africa, as well as an abundance of hippo, buffalo, antelope and lion.

Game-drive are conducted by professional guides in open 4 x 4 game viewing vehicles. Motorised boat safaris explore the Chobe River with professional guides.

Sundowner Cruises are spectacular for sunsets on the Chobe River.

Fishing excursions are also available at an additional cost (pre-booking is advised.)

Your stay at Chobe Chilwero is inclusive of accommodation, all meals, all local brand drinks, scheduled safari activities, park entrance fees and laundry.

***Included:*** Light aircraft flight from Chief's Camp to Chobe Chilwero, 2 nights Chobe Chilwero, accommodation, all meals, local brand beverages, laundry service, national park fees and activities

***Excluded:*** Premium brand beverages and curio purchases

**Note:** Fishing is an additional activity and is at an additional cost. You are welcome to pre book, should you wish to do some fishing.

**Day 7:**

After an early morning activity and breakfast, if time permits, you will transfer to Kasane Airport in time for your onward connection.
